- The Respect Rule

4. not discriminate against my fellow students and teachers
5. play sport fairly
6. not use verbal abuse
7. always be truthful and honest
8. ask permission before using others peoples' belongings

- The Safety Rule

I must act and play safely and allow others to play safely

I have the responsibility to:

1. be in the right place at the right time
2. not threaten, hit, hurt or tease others

- The Environment Rule

I must take care of my school

I have the responsibility to:

1. help keep my school clean and tidy
2. take care of buildings, furniture and all school property

- The School Pride Rule

I must show others that I am proud of my school

I have the responsibility to:

1. wear the correct school and sports uniform
2. behave well on excursions and when travelling to and from school.
